



Bukovinian State Medical University is founded in 1944, located in the West of Ukraine, included into the general register of the WHO, Magna Charta Universitatum (Bologna, Italy), the Association of the Carpathian Region Universities. BSMU consists of 47 departments within 7 faculties: 4 medical faculties, dentistry, pharmaceutical, and the faculty of post-graduate training and preparatory departments for Ukrainian and foreign students.

Nowadays number of students is more than 5000 including 1000 foreign citizens.

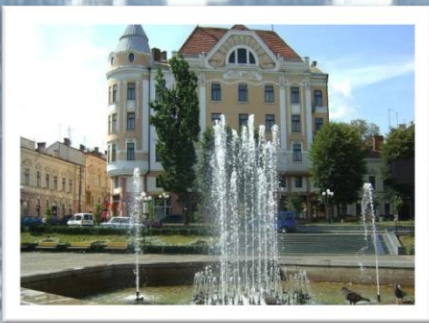




The University teaching staff is 83 Doctors of Science, 324 Candidates of Science, including 1 corresponding member of the Academy of Pedagogical Science of Ukraine, 2 Honoured Workers of Science and Technique of Ukraine, 2 Honoured Workers of Education and Higher School of Ukraine, 13 Honoured Physicians of Ukraine, 66 Professors, 193 Associate Professors. 166 employees have higher attestation medical category, 56 – the first one, 42 – the second one.

The material-technical base of the University is located in 22 buildings, and municipal and regional medical establishments are used for clinical departments. 6 students' hostels of Bukovinian State Medical University are located closely to principal buildings and clinics of the university.

For the development of creative abilities and rest of the students the Palace “Academichny” is functioning actively.





The University provides continuity of higher medical education: Junior Specialist → Bachelor → Medical Specialist → Master → post graduate education. If students already graduated from other medical university it is possible to apply for Clinical Residency, PhD programs (27 specialities), Doctor of Medicine (6 specialities).

The instruction is provided in Ukrainian and English languages on the following specialities:

- General Medicine (Medical Specialist, Master);**
- Pediatrics (Medical Specialist, Master);**
- Medical Psychology (Medical Specialist);**
- Dentistry (Medical Specialist, Master);**
- Clinical Pharmacy (Medical Specialist, Master);**
- Nursing (Junior Specialist, Bachelor, Master);**
- Laboratory Diagnostics (Bachelor);**
- Pharmacy (Junior Specialist, Medical Specialist, Bachelor).**



The University performs primary post-graduate specialization of graduates (Internship) and advanced training, specialization and requalification of physicians including foreign citizens in Residency in the specialties of medical and pediatric profile, Pharmacy and Medical Psychology.



Experience of BSMU

University Montpellier 1, France

30 students from BSMU undertook practical course in France and 7 lectures from University Montpellier 1 gave a series of lectures in BSMU.

Suceava University "Stefan cel Mare", Romania

More than 200 students of both establishments participate in joint intercultural activities in the framework of Bukovinian University Consortium.

University of Luebeck, Germany

29 students from BSMU undertook summer practical course in the Partner University, while 11 students from Lubeck came to our establishment.

Psychiatric Clinics of Munsterlingen, Switzerland

9 postgraduate students from BSMU undertook course in psychiatric clinics of Munsterlingen. 11 teachers and lecturers from Switzerland and 10 from BSMU made speeches, master-workshops and lectured in psychology at the premises of both institutions.





The curriculum in BSMU is based on the principles of the European credit-transfer system, including: learning of training disciplines, structured on modules; the introduction of testing credits ECTS as a unit of a student's training load measurement, necessary for mastering of a training discipline; the application of different scales of evaluation, including the absolute national scale and the ECTS scale.

To obtain the local diploma the student must satisfy the programme requirements as prescribed in the Programm Specification. A successful completion of the syllabus envisages acquiring by a person, to whom the «physician» qualification is given, of general and special fundamental and professionally oriented knowledge, abilities, skills, competencies, necessary for the fulfillment of standart professional tasks, connected with his/her activities in an appropriate position in the medical sphere.
